- An excellent Dyeing Laboratory, Design Section, Weaving Section, Printing Section, Library and Documentation Section and Computer Aided Textile Design Section for sample development, training, expert guidance and for extension services.

OUR ARMS FOR SERVICE

Design Section

• Artists drawn from the best talent available in art schools are constantly, engaged in preparing paper designs. These designs comprise both for weaving and for hand block printing. The attempt is to preserve traditional designs by reviving them and/or adopting them to the requirements of the market. These designs help in production of items both for domestic and export markets. The CAD facility available helps in preparing the designs and techniques with the aid of a computer. This Centre has the services of Jala Makers, Graph Paper Designers who work in cloth association with the Dyeing Laboratory and the Weaving Section. Care is taken to see that the designs developed are within the discipline imposed by the types of yarn, dyestuffs and weaving techniques as per requirements of the sector.

Weaving Section

• Skilled weavers drawn from the main traditional weaving communities of the countryman the Weaving Section. They are supervised by qualified Textile Technologists. Facilities of prototype looms and weaving equipments are available in the Section. Fabrics in new designs and new textures are produced using different yarns. The section also undertakes simple improvements in looms and in the processes of weaving.

Dyeing Laboratory

• The Dyeing Laboratory works in Office premises. This Laboratory brings out number of new shades in Cotton and to some extent in silk and wool both in Vegetable and Synthetic colors. However, the Dyeing Laboratory possesses new shade cards for silk, cotton and these shade cards illustrate a number of shades in use in the field of handlooms and also give details of the method of application of dye stuffs, temperatures to be maintained and the length of dyeing period for each

shade. These cards also provide information on degumming, scouring, bleaching, dyeing, etc. and the equipments used in dyeing and testing methods.

Printing Section:

• Fully equipped Printing Section manned by experienced Printers and other Qualified Technical Personnel capable of developing Techniques in cost processing of fabrics is available in the premises of Weavers' Service Centre, Vijayawada., This Section carries out experiments in the preparation of basic materials for Hand-block printing. The Section also fully equipped to carry Vegetable Prints with Hand-Blocks. Dischargeable and Non-dischargeable dyestuffs have been effectively used to obtain multiple effects of rare beauty. The Section has greater expertise in Block Printing of Vegetable Colours and cordially develop new designs and patterns. The Section also has expertise in making Hand-blocks.

Library and Documentation Section:

 A collection of cloth samples, photographs, books and periodicals dealing with various aspects of the textile industry is available in these Sections. In an attempt to augment the resources of the Weavers' Service Centre, Vijayawada, there is a proposal to acquire a sizeable collection of books and periodicals to form a Library.

OUR CHARTER OF SERVICES

I. DESIGN DEVELOPMENT:

- The Designs developed in the Centre either in Design Section, Weaving Section or Printing Section are supplied to the Handloom Agencies, such as, Apex Societies, viz., APCO, APTEX, Primary Weavers' Co-op. Societies, Manufacturers of Handloom Products and exporters of Handloom Goods.
- While providing designs to the Handloom Agencies a nominal charges approved by the Development Commissioner for Handlooms, New Delhi are collected from the Agency. The rates are given in Annexure-
- The Weavers in the Weaving Section of Weavers' Service Centre, Vijayawada develop new fabric samples using different types of yarns, viz., Cotton, Jute, Silk, Wool and other manmade fibres by adopting different techniques and equipments, such as treadle, Dobby, Jala, Jacquard etc. The samples so developed are supplied to production units of

Handloom Products to improve their marketability both in local and export. While supplying the samples to Handloom Agencies a nominal

charges are collected approved by the Development Commissioner for Handlooms, New Delhi. The rates are given in Annexure-I.

- The Printing Section of Weavers' Service Centre, Vijayawada carries out printing of Home Furnishings in silk, cotton, Jute materials mainly with Vegetable colours using Hand-Blocks. It also carries printing of Dress materials both in cotton and silk. The Printings are carried out under the guidance of Art Designers using traditional motives with new layouts and colour combinations keeping its end use. These samples are supplied to Printing Units located around Vijayawada as well as individuals. The charges are collected as per the approved rates from the parties who collected the samples-
- Weavers' Service Centre, Vijayawada is linked with Ncm in order to provide information to weavers in terms of fast changing consumer preferences, fashion trends and technological developments in the means of communication both within and abroad.

2. TRAINING:

- Weavers' Service Centre, Vijayawada impart training through Modified Decentralised Training Programme Scheme to Semiskilled and Skilled weavers sponsored by State Handloom Authorities through Co-op. Societies or N.G.Os. to upgrade their skills for product development, product diversification and improvement in productivity in weaving, Dyeing Technique and Design Development. The duration of the Training is 2 months in Weaving, One month in Designing and 15 days in Dyeing and conduct at the places of beneficiaries paying a stipend of Rs.551per day. No fee is collected from the Trainees. The Weaver and/or beneficiary must be semi-skilled or skilled below the age of 40 years and who can read and write in local language. A Master Trainer selected from the Discipline must undergo a familiarization Training Programme for 15 days at Weavers' Service Centre, Vijayawada. He will be paid a stipend of Rs.75/per day during Familiarization training and Rs.2500/-P .M. as Honorarium, while conducting training to the Trainees.
- Weavers' Service Centre, Vijayawada provide Observatory
 Training in the premises of this Centre on specified special
 techniques of Weaving, Designing, Vegetable Printing, Batik
 Printing, Chemical Printing using Hand-Blocks for a period of one
 month collecting a fee of Rs.600/- as three technical assistance
 charges @ Rs.200/- each.(approved in the South Zone Officers-inCharge meeting at Cannanore).

3. TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE:

Weavers' Service Centre, Vijayawada provide the following technical services to the beneficiaries in the Industry as follows:

- Provide technical data on a given fabric sample for its reproduction to the Societies and other Production Units charging a nominal fee as approved by the Department.
- Provide Technical Assistance for the purchase of new looms by the Cooperative Societies.
- Provide Training to the Master Trainers sponsored by the Weavers' Co-op, Societies under various Project Package Schemes sanctioned to the Co-op. Societies in the State so as to enable them to conduct training to the beneficiaries under this Scheme.
- Provide Technical Assistance in setting up of looms to conduct Training Programmes in Weaving to the Weavers under Project Package Scheme.
- Provide technical assistance to the Weavers in the field of rectifying the malfunctioning of the improved gadgets attached to the looms.
- Provide technical assistance to the beneficiaries in matching of given shades charging a nominal fee as approved.
- Submit Water Analysis Reports and advise the suitability of Water for Dyeing purpose charging a nominal fee as approved.
- Extend Technical Assistance on fastness of shades as well as Printing Techniques used in Textile Printing.

OUR ACTIVITIES:

1. EXHIBITION

- Weavers' Service Centre, Vijayawada holds Dyeing cum Design Exhibitions in the interior clusters of weavers to familiarize them with the latest and the best in the dyeing and design techniques-
- Weavers' Service Centre, Vijayawada arrange live demonstration of improved techniques of Weaving and Printing to create awareness of the developments in general and to the weavers in particular at Appropriate Technology Exhibitions organised by NHDC & National Handloom Expos sponsored by Development Commissioner for Handlooms, New Delhi throughout India.
- Weavers' Service Centre, Vijayawada submit exclusive cloth samples developed in this Centre for display in the Theme Pavilion of National Handloom Expos. sponsored by Development Commissioner for Handlooms, New Delhi through out India to create awareness of the latest designs developed in Handloom Sector.

2. RESEARCH & DEVELOPMENT:

- Weavers' Service Centre, Vijayawada is carrying R & D Work for Loom development, Design modification, Development of Natural and/or Vegetable colours, Unique Sample Development.
- To do in-house work for the improvement of various machinery and appliances used by the Handloom Industry and other trades or Industries.
- To investigate into and help improvement of various processes of Manufacture with a view to securing greater efficiency rationalization and reduction of costs.

3. MONITORING OF SCHEMES:

 Monitoring the implementation of Handloom Schemes such as P.P.S., H.D.C. Q.D.U., I.H.V.D., Work shed cum Housing, DDHPY AND DEPM Schemes sanctioned to Weavers' Co-op. Societies in the coastal Districts of Andhra Pradesh including Chittoor and advise the Societies in proper utilisation of funds under various heads.

4. HANDLOOM RESERV ATION ACT:

• Weavers' Service Centre, Vijayawada conduct visits to the Power-loom Units for Enforcement of Handloom Reservation Act.

5. DOCUMENTATION:

• Weavers' Service Centre, Vijayawada documenting the Traditional samples and/or Designs including Samples developed in the Centre with all Technical Data for future references.

6. MARKET SUPPORT:

• Weavers' Service Centre, Vijayawada provides marketing guidance by nominating and forwarding Weavers and/or Master Weavers for participation in Delhi Haat, Surajkund Mela, Taj Mahotsav, Udaipur Craft Mela, Shilparamam etc. to promote marketing of handloom goods

7. PROMOTION OF EXCELLENCE:

 Weavers' Service Centre, Vijayawada recommends from the area of Coastal Districts of Andhra Pradesh including Chittoor, the Weaver, Master Weaver, Printer and others developing outstanding Handloom Products for National Award to be presented by the President of India to recognise the skill of the outstanding Craftsmen.
